





Personal Appearance

Burkinabè wear both African and Western clothing. In rural settings, men wear a robe (boubou), while women wear a wraparound skirt (pagne) with a blouse or T-shirt. In cities, women wear elaborate, colorful African outfits made of locally designed or imported fabrics. Men used to often wear the tenue de fonctionnaire (civil servant suit, with shirt and pants made of the same cloth), but now slacks or jeans with shirts made of colorful pagne fabric are more common. Imported suits are cheaper than locally made suits.

Both rural and urban dwellers buy used clothing imported from Europe, Asia, and the United States. However, former president Thomas Sankara called for consumption of local products, an idea civic leaders continue to advocate. As a result, embroidered traditional outfits have become more popular attire for social events.

Women often have elaborate hairstyles and change them every few weeks; wealthier women may change them as frequently as twice a week. Braided extensions, wigs, and "spikes" of hair (made by wrapping hair with black thread) are common. Although on the decline, traditional face

Gestures

Burkinabè use the right hand to greet people, pass items, and eat. Using the left hand, especially for greeting or eating, is extremely offensive. Some believe that a left-handed child is possessed by evil spirits, and parents often train their children to use the right hand. Men and women hold hands in public with friends of the same gender, but public displays of affection between men and women are usually inappropriate. In some areas, small gestures such as gifts, invitations, holding hands, short kisses, or bringing meat or chickens home can show love.

To motion to someone using the index finger is considered disrespectful; instead, one motions with the palm of the hand down. Many Burkinabè avoid calling out someone's name

unless the person is nearby because of a belief that the devil may overhear the name, call it out, and thereby cause the person to die. As a result, people only respond to their name when they can see the person calling out. If the person is farther away, it is polite to whistle or make a loud "pssst" noise in order to get his or her attention. Burkinabè express disgust at events or actions by rounding the lips and making a






Locating Critically Referenced Sources - Main Screen





Locating Critically Referenced Sources - Publication search






- Identify by Source Type, such as Scholarly Journals, Books, Pamphlets, Reports, etc.
- Locate content from familiar titles such as Journals of Gerontology, Journal of Integrated Care, or Adolescent Health, Medicine, and Therapeutics


Locating Critically Referenced Sources

Publication Search

Search key identifying terms in title, subject, or publication summary







Advanced Search

Isolate key search terms - be specific to the fields searched, such as subject, title, abstract, etc.

Use additional limiters - "Source type" or "Document type" -- to find items such as

- Dissertations & Theses,
- Scholarly Journals
- **Evidence Based Healthcare**











How to Locate Video Content - Basic Search







How to Locate Video Content - Adanced Search








How to Use the Video Clips




Using the Thesaurus

- The Nursing & Allied Health Premium is indexed by the ProQuest main hierarchical system of controlled terms, or Thesaurus
- Using this indexing system ensures a more efficient recall.






- Enter the term as you know it in the Search terms box and click on Find
- The visual Thesaurus will show the most similar terms.
- Some have a check box, others are only hyperlinks.
- The selectable ones are Preferred terms, the others are Synonyms and can be used as pointers.
- Check the relevant term or click on the synonym to detect the Preferred term.
- When a Preferred term is checked you can click on Add to search





The visual Thesaurus will place the search terms in the Advanced Search form with the correct syntax

Evaluate the results and apply the proper filters if needed

Please note: Thesaurus searching is very useful to pick efficiently a good selection of very relevant documents. Might need to be integrated with a free-text search to be more comprehensive.
